

Well done team! Mr Shaughnessy





We have enjoyed collecting leaves and flowers as part of our Science learning and then created some wonderful portraits.





#### Year 1

This week in Year 1, we have been learning about different measures including height, weight and length. We have also been working hard during our Mastering Number sessions to learn our number doubles.

### Year 2

This week in Year 2 we have been learning to find the difference using pictograms. We created our own giant pictogram and used it to answer tricky questions. Super learning!











#### Year 3

In art this week, we have been developing our drawing skills and techniques by using a variety of pencil effects to draw a portrait. We learned the basic proportions of the face and looked carefully at the light source so that we could create a 3D effect. We have some truly incredible artists in year 3!



#### Year 4

In Geography, 4L and 4F have been learning the different OS symbols found on maps. After learning the symbols, we used them to find these features on maps from various locations. Great map skills year 4!





#### Year 5

In our science lesson this week, year 5 have been dissecting flowering plants to discover which parts are responsible for reproduction. We used microscopes to observe the pollen on the anther, and opened up the plant to view the ovules. We definitely have some budding botanists!
