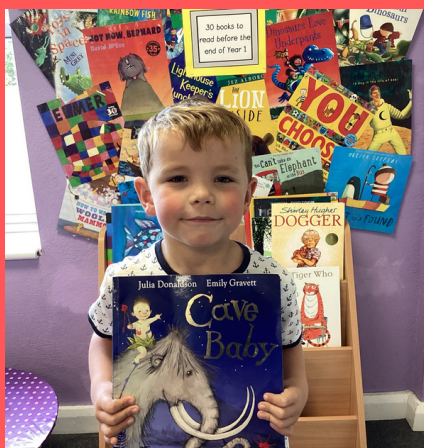
Rainbows and Sunbeams

Pointillism is art created by using dots to form a picture or a pattern. We used different colours, patterns and tools to create our pointillism painting. We used cotton wool balls and cotton buds to create large and small dots. They are beautiful and colourful. What do you think?
