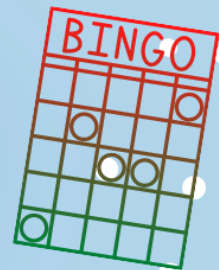

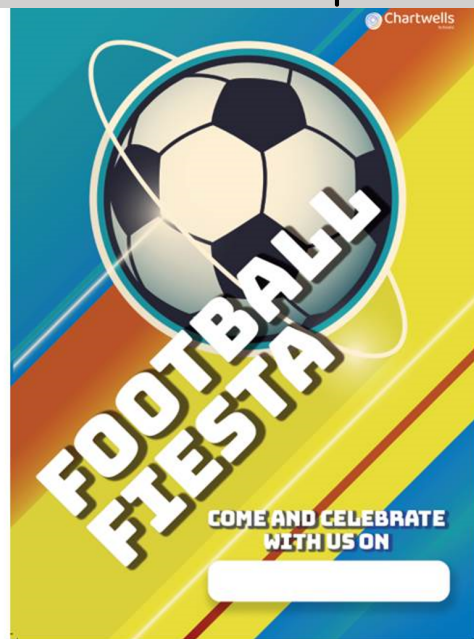

School Uniform Shop

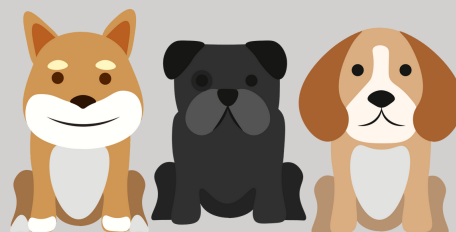
Preloved uniforms are available in the hall next week during parent's meetings in exchange for a small cash donation towards our latest PTA fundraising project for new playground equipment.

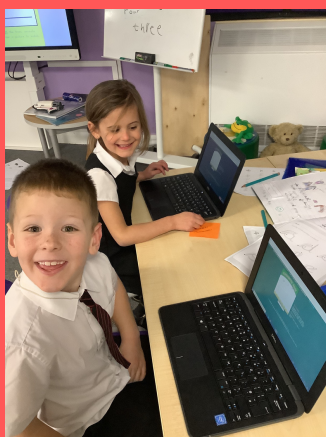
Rainbows and Sunbeams

Year 3

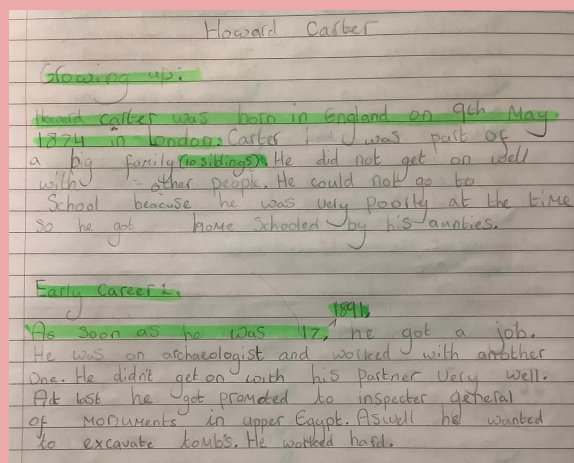

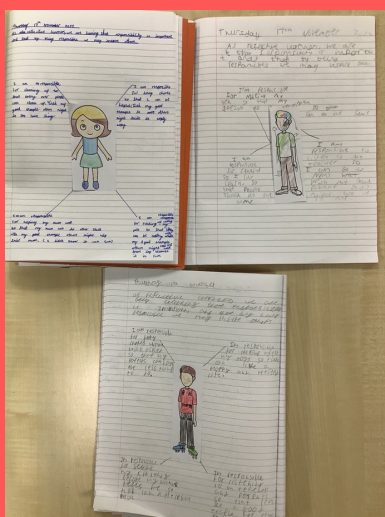
Year 4

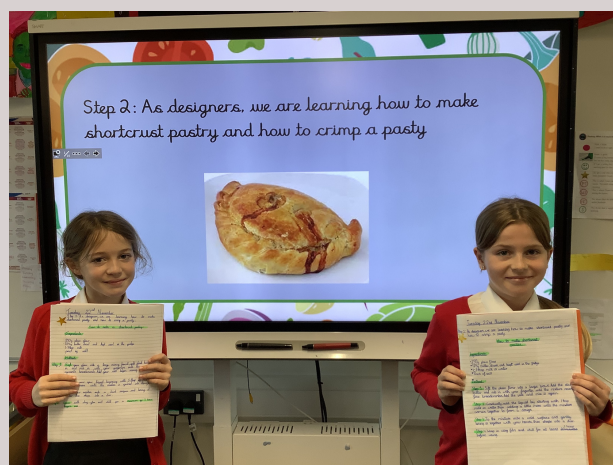
Year 5
