Identify the significant event/person/ place - who/ what/when?	What do we want to find out about the significant event/person/ place?	What can we use to find the answers to our questions? Consider a range of sources.	Why is the significant event/person/ place important?	What was the impact of the significant event/person/ place on people's lives/my life?	Recall key facts about the person, place or event studied and understand why this is important in their life.
Place the significant event/person/ place (starting with initial date, e.g. birth of significant person) on class timeline.	Place key dates of the significant event/person/ place on a timeline.				Explain understanding of sources of evidence using phrases such as 'we know this because'. Order events and objects, using a timeline to show understanding of past and present.
