Reception have enjoyed problem solving and working together to create large scale shape pictures. The classroom looked like a wonderful art exhibition.



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

Ave Weekly Usage (mins)



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


Year 1

Year 3


In Year 3, we have been learning about the pollination process in science. We used drama to help us understand how pollen is transferred from one flower to another.
