In Reception, we have been using a tens frame to support us with our counting. We have been using collections of practical objects and tens frames to help us think about numbers which total 10.






Year 1

In PSHE, Year 2 have been learning how to call 999 in a fire emergency and made a fire plan of their home.






Year 3
