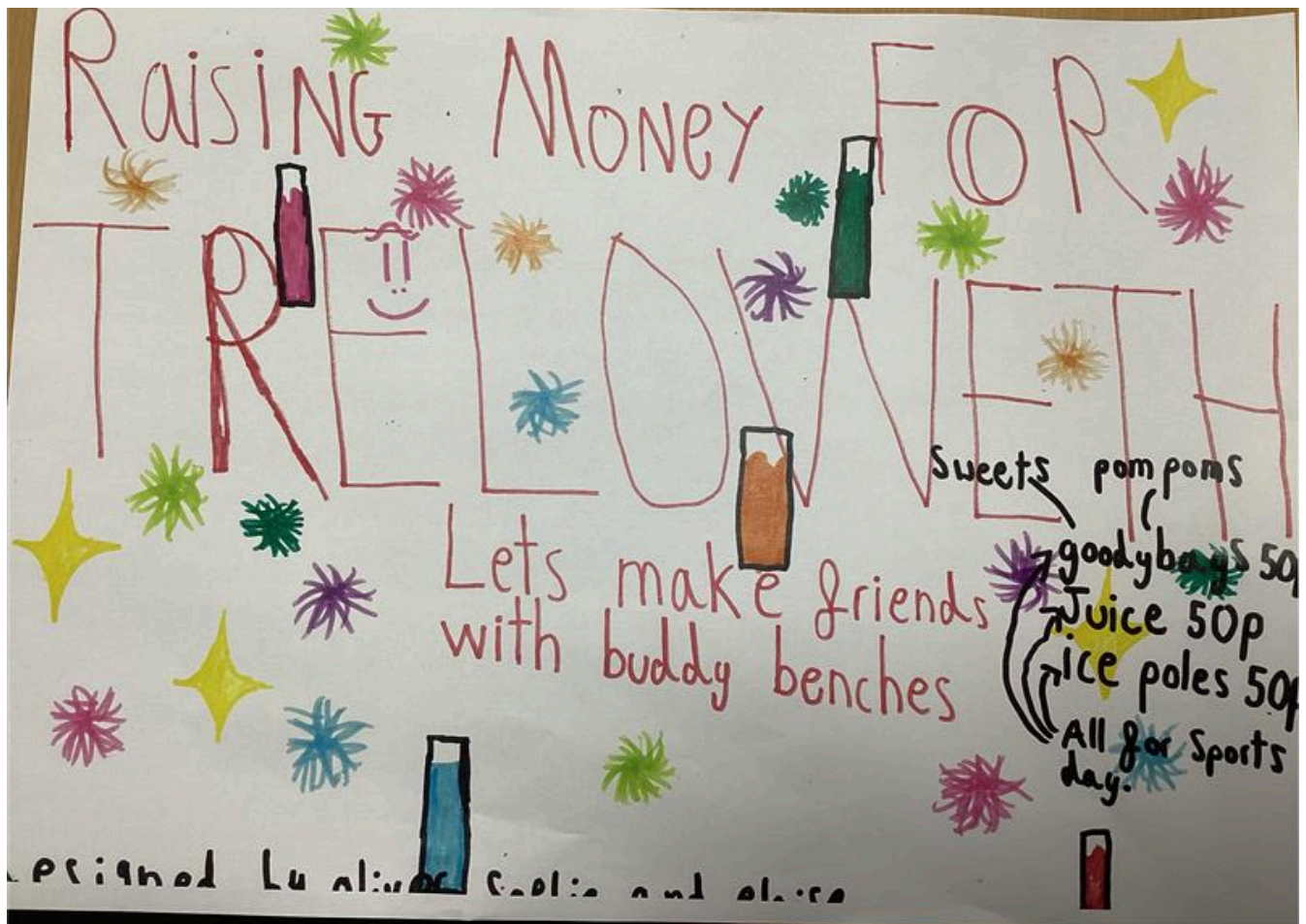




Kiara competed last weekend at the Starz Uk competition in Bristol and came 3rd in her solo; 2nd in her trio and in her group came 3rd and 2nd.
