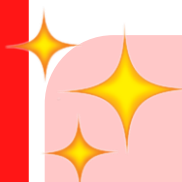

Year 3 have returned full of enthusiasm as seen here in our active maths lessons!



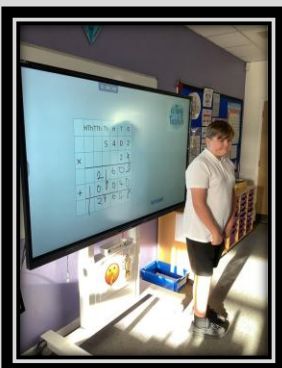
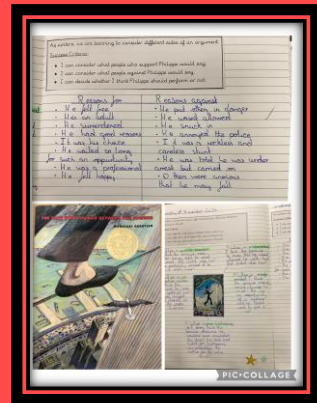


Year 4
