Rainbows and Sunbeams

In EYFS this week, we have been investigating insects. We went on an insect hunt to see which insects live in our outside area.



Year 1

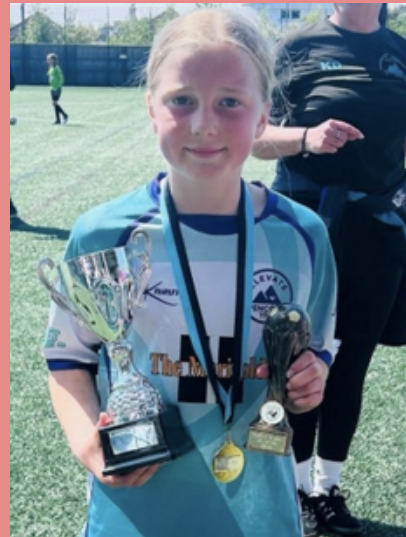

I was incredibly proud to complete a 26-mile trek in the Peak District at the weekend, raising money for CoppaFeel! —a charity close to my heart that raises awareness of breast cancer in young people. This challenge was especially meaningful after securing a place in the London marathon in 2020 after my mum was diagnosed with breast cancer, but it was cancelled due to covid. The trek helped me raise over £670 for the charity while encouraging early awareness and understanding for future generations.

School Uniform

All pupils at Treloweth Primary School, are expected to follow this dress code and will be encouraged to take pride in their appearance. The school colours are red, black and white and the required dress is as follows:

- Trousers, shorts or skirts — black school uniform style only.
 - Shirt (long or short sleeve) — white only.
 - Tie.
- Pullover or cardigan — plain red or with school logo only.
 - Summer dress — red check.
- Black shoes- with black soles; not boots.

Please note: trainers, skate shoes, Crocs or similar are not to be worn — children wearing any item from this list to school will be expected to change into plimsolls.



PE Kit to be worn on PE days:

- Black shorts/leggings.
 - Plain red T-shirt.
- Black trainers/ plimsolls.
 - White/black socks.
- Black tracksuit bottoms for outdoor games.
 - Red sweatshirt.



School Uniform

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's name. This makes returning any items easy.

PE bags, book bags, sun hats, baseball caps, water bottles and school ties are available to buy from the main reception.

We have a selection of good quality pre-loved uniform available in the school office.

Please note:

- Jewellery, with the exception of a watch or one pair of small stud earring, should not be worn.

- Shoulder length hair should be tied back with red/ black hair accessories only.
- Hair should not be dyed, coloured, gelled, less than a grade 3 cut, patterned an extreme fashion statement.
