## Rainbows and Sunbeams

In Reception, we have been exploring different ways of making 10 using numicon, multi-link and other practical resources.



## Year 1

## Year 2

In Year 2, we have been exploring traditional fairy tales in English. We have been reading 'The Magic Porridge Pot' and have used adjectives to create our own descriptions of the main characters from the story.

Year 3 have been loving their new coding unit in computing. We've been using the Indi cars and programming them through coloured mats to complete a sequence of instructions.

## Year 5

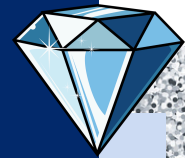

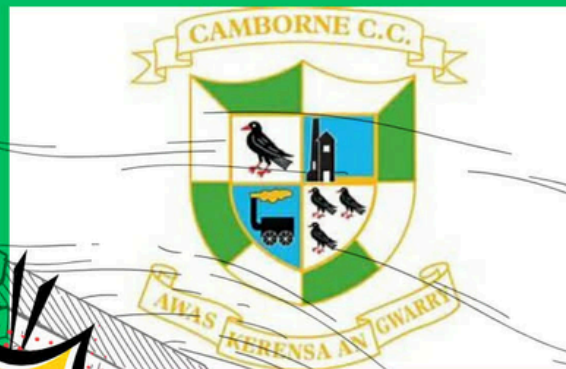
# History enrichment day

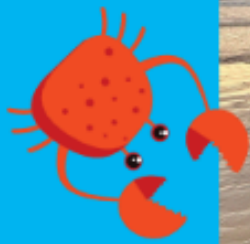
