In our Drawing club, we have been sharing the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs'. We brought the story to life by creating our very own houses from sticks and bricks. Can you spot who are the little pigs and who are the big, bad Wolves?



Year 1

Year 1 children have been learning about the artist Hundertwasser in their art lessons. They explored different painting techniques by using a variety of tools to create texture and interesting effects. The children also designed and created their own repeating patterns, inspired by Hundertwasser's colourful and imaginative style.

Year 2

In our Art lessons, we have been learning about Talavera pottery. This is a very special type of pottery which is produced in Puebla, Mexico. After looking at various examples and creating our own designs, we had a go at moulding clay and carving our own ideas into our Talavera inspired tiles.



Year 3

In science, we have been learning about the parts of a plant and the life cycle of plants. We've learned about pollination and seed dispersal.

Year 4

This week, Year 4 has been learning all about Christian beliefs and how the Holy Spirit is represented in artwork.
