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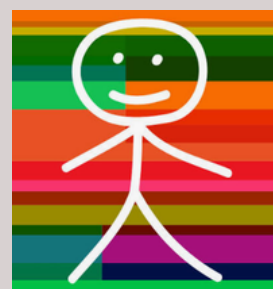
UPDATE TO OUR SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS 26/27

At Treloweth, we are proud to be a listening school. Following feedback from our recent parent survey, one of the key themes raised was communication between home and school. Thank you to everyone who took the time to share their views; your feedback helps us to continually improve the experience we provide for children and families.

After carefully reviewing our current systems and considering the feedback received, we are pleased to announce that from September we will be moving from Class Dojo to MySchoolApp.

We believe this new platform will provide a clearer, more consistent and more effective way for families to stay connected with school life. Through MySchoolApp, parents will be able to:

- Receive important school messages and updates in one place.
- Access newsletters, letters and key information quickly and easily.
- Complete forms and permissions electronically.
- Keep up to date with events and school activities.
- Receive notifications directly to their device.
- Reduce the chance of important communications being missed.
- Benefit from a more consistent communication experience across the whole school.



Whilst MySchoolApp will become our main communication platform, we know that successful partnerships are built through a range of opportunities to engage with school life. We will therefore continue to offer:

- Class presentations and parent information sessions.
- Learning Share events where children can celebrate and showcase their learning.
- A dedicated SEND email hotline for support and enquiries.
- Reading record communication to support reading at home.
- End-of-day learning share opportunities, enabling parents to hear directly from children and staff about their learning.

This change reflects our commitment to listening, responding and continually improving. We are excited about the opportunities MySchoolApp will bring and look forward to working together to strengthen the partnership between home and school even further.

Next week, we will share a step-by-step guide on how to register for MySchoolApp, ensuring all families are ready to access the platform before September.

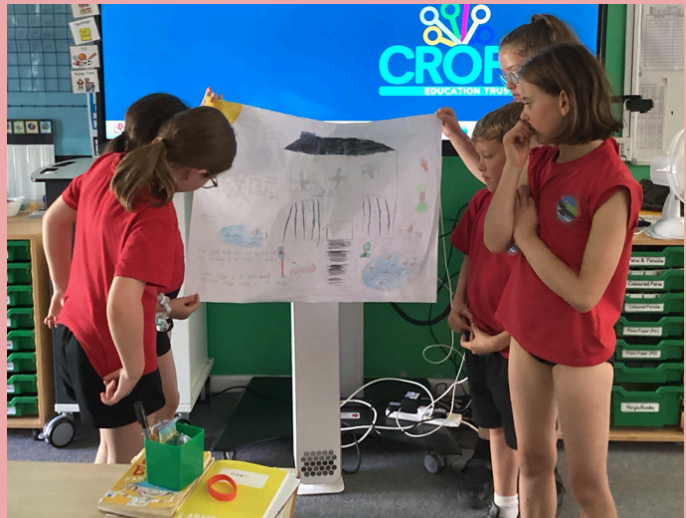


Year 3
